Create a fact file or poster about the human body.

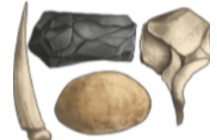


Include:

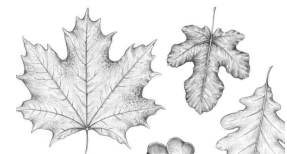
